Booster President Corrie Lanzer called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

Corrie asked for Committee Reports.

Treasurer's Report: Erin Powers - Treasurer

- 1. Erin read the Treasurer's Report. It can be found at the end of the minutes.
- 2. Erin has sent more letters to the IRS to get our past non-profit filings up to date.

Concessions Report: Concession Chair – Becky Cobb

- 1. A copy of the basketball sign-ups is on the table.

There are fees involved with virtually everything we do as it would be a commercial account. Corrie noted she's not opposed but it has to be profitable or it's not worth it. Band has many months where we don't run concessions yet we'd still be paying a monthly charge. Minimum purchase amounts for card use would definitely need to be in place.

- 4. All students who will be performing at Solo & Ensemble Contest on January 27th will be performing at the dinner. Choir students will go first, then percussion. Connor Cole will be performing with the 8th Grade Honors Band at Alliance High School that same evening. Mr. Pendergast will be setting up, leaving for AHS to watch Connor, then returning to provide comments for the remainder of the band student performances.
- 5. People will be asked to move to chairs up by the stage after eating in order to free up table space.
- 6. Michelle, Lisa and Felicia will be providing desserts. Erin and Betsy will be selling raffle and 50/50 tickets. Roasters are being borrowed from the Washington Township Fire Department. Corrie and Lisa will cook the pasta.

 - d. Students earning a I or a II can purchase medals. They are \$4, cash.
 - e. Food will be available in the cafeteria.
 - f. Mr. Pendergast will be taking keyboards, snare drums and music to S&E. Students will otherwise be responsible for transporting their own instruments.
- 4. For Large Group on March 9th, we will be taking buses to Lake High School. Parents can watch the performance but not the sight-reading portion. Again, no photographs or videoing permitted. The music will also be played at the March 5th concert.
