Treasury Report - Erin Powers - Treasurer

- Sausages cost is 1.49 to make, sells for 5.00, more profitable than Arby's sandwiches
- Dollar Dog night upcoming football game on 9/20. Office Collins donated the dogs and buns for the event
- Credit card machine not working on the away side, having WiFi issues. Had to use a hotspot to make it work
- Concession stand sign ups parents need to sign up by Thursday if helping out
- Referee meals discussed providing meals for the referees in exchange for band parents being able to get into the football games.
 - 1. Betsy called for a vote to continue this with the referees. Motioned by Michelle Hosmer, Carrie Lane was second
- This Saturday's concession stand shift is covered!!!!!!

<u>Fundraising</u>

- Text Fundraiser- decided to do it again next year since it was successful this year
- Cane's money hasn't been received from fundraiser yet
- Beef Raffle 15 tickets is all we needed to sell to cover the processing cost. We have sold 40 tickets so far
- Popcorn starts on 9/11 and order forms need to be turned in on 9/27. 7th and 8th grades are part of the fundraiser, 6th grade is not. 50% of this will go to NYC, the other half will go to the general band fund.

- Bake sale will be having the sale during 2 different home football games -Homecoming/Alumni night and Senior night. All proceeds from the bake sale will go to the NYC trip
- November Chipotle dine and donate
- December bake sale at Frosty's
- January Pepperoni Rolls

Band Manager

 - 1. Voted yes by Becky Cobb, second by Angela Cole. \$6,718 will have to come out of the band fund for the purchase.

- We will be feeding the kids between the 2 shows. We are looking at Dogwood Park in North Canton as a stopping place, coming back to the HS would be out of the way.
- Michelle Hosmer coordinating the food. She's picking up subs, but we need donations of water, cookies and chips

- The field commander and 2 seniors will be on the field for the awards
- We will stop at Dogwood park in between shows to feed the kids and give them some downtime
